GENERAL

- 1. A list for each interscholastic activity, athletic and non-athletic, is required.
- 2. The Master Eligibility List must be on file at the school at least 3 days prior to your first competition in that activity. The eligibility information must be sent to the League Office immediately upon request.
- 3. Copies of the Master Eligibility List should be furnished to member schools in accordance with the Data Privacy Act upon request from the member school.
- 4. An addendum list must be completed and kept on file when additional students become participants.
- 5. List all eligible students, including transfer students, in the column headed Names of Eligible Students.
- 6. Transfer Students: A transfer student is any student entering your high school EXCEPT for those students coming from a junior high school or middle school that are regular continuation schools for your high school district. A transfer student is granted eligibility for varsity competition when any of the conditions listed in the section entitled Bylaw 111.00—Transfer and Residence in the current MSHSL Official Handbook have been met. Please indicate the condition of transfer that applies in the area marked Basis for Granting Eligibility.
