Football and Volleyball End of Season Guidance and Information

Required by Emergency Executive Order 20-99, all in-person activities—including practices, group workouts, games, and tournaments must be completed or stopped effective 11:59 p.m. on Friday, November 20, 2020.

Football

- Regions may adjust the time, date, location or matchups of remaining contests.
- Teams may compete in no more than two contests during the week of November 16-20, 2020.
 - If a team competed on Tuesday, November 17, 2020, they are only able to compete on Friday, November 20, 2020.
 - Note: Sports Medicine Advisory has reviewed the potential situation where football teams would play on Tuesday and on Friday in the last week of the season and has approved this schedule in the last week of a season only.
- Trophies and medals may be awarded for section football events. These may be champion and runner-up or section finalist awards.

Volleyball

- Volleyball contests during the week of November 16-20, 2020, are regular season contests.
- These contests are hosted by member schools and must abide by the regular season guidance provided at the beginning of the season.
- This includes:
 - Teams may play one opponent per day. This may be a single match or a doubleheader.
 - Contests may be duals only. No Invitationals or tournaments are allowed. This means that no more than two teams may compete at a single location in a single day.
 - Teams may not exceed 14 regular season contests.
- Exception to Maximum number of matches per week:
 - A volleyball team may schedule four contests in a week during the last week of the season, November 16-20, 2020.
