Streaming Exceptions for 2019-2021 Postseason Media Guidance and Information

Tuesday, March 2, 2021

During the 2020-2021 school year, the Minnesota State High School League will grant an exception to the postseason section event live streaming guidelines for member schools and professional media found in the Media Policy Manual. This exception provides the opportunity for member schools and media outlets to share a live video stream of activities during a time when attendance is limited because of state mandates and safety protocols.

Permitted:

- School Space Media --- www.prepspotlight.tv
- NFHS Network/Pixellot System
Approval required from the NFHS Network, the League and the Region Secretary. Member schools must initiate the approval process by submitting a request to the Region Secretary.
- A member school's YouTube channel
- A member school's Facebook Live
- Registered Community Media Systems
- Registered Radio Partners
- Others not listed above will be considered by the League

Not permitted:

- Twitter
- Periscope

Approval process:

1. Member schools and media outlets must request permission of the Region Secretary that oversees their postseason contests. Contact information for a Region Secretary may be found here:

2. Media outlets must meet rights fees requirements, if applicable
3. Prior to approval, the Region Secretary will consult with the League.
