Parking

- **SPECTATOR PARKING & SHUTTLE SERVICE:** Spectator parking is free and available at McLane's Shipping off Armstrong Road and across the street from the St. Olaf campus. Large signs on Hwy 19 will direct spectators to this lot. Shuttle service to and from campus and the parking lot will be provided from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm on race day and is also free of charge. The shuttle pickup and drop off points will be posted with large "Shuttle Stop" signs. Please note: Spectator parking is not allowed on the St. Olaf campus or in any of the Skoglund Athletic Center parking lots. Security will be at each entry point of campus and will only admit buses and team vans with official parking passes, and vehicles with a current disability permit or license plates. For your safety and for the flow of traffic, please do not attempt to cross Hwy 19 on foot; shuttles will be readily available and will run continually between the parking lot and race venue.

Spectator Policies and Information

- **SPECTATORS ON COURSE:** Instruct spectators from your school to stay behind the fences in order that all runners will have a fair opportunity to do their best. Spectator interference may result in disqualification of a team or individual. Please remind your fans of the restricted course area in and near the Prairie Loop and the Dorm loop.
- Guests should stay home if they are sick or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19
- Camera tri-pods/mono-pods and “selfie sticks” are NOT allowed.
- No beverages, food or noisemakers will be allowed to be brought into the facility.
- No balloons, laser pointers, noisemakers, air-horns, horns, drums, or whistles will be allowed in the facility.
- No weapons of any kind including licensed concealed carry weapons, knives, etc.
- No signs or banners may be hung in the facility. Hand-held signs allowed (can be held by one person)
- No drones allowed.
