## Classification

#### Postseason:

- 50 % of teams are eliminated from postseason play in the first competition.
- Schools have local control of their regular season schedule.

### Philosophy

• The philosophy of tournament competition for the League is to extend the opportunity for student participation in a variety of activities at the section and state levels. Region committees conduct contests, meets and tournaments in accordance with League rules and regulations which advance student participants to the next level of competition. (4/28/83)





h) Prior to any classification determination, schools who believe their school demographics unfairly place their team sports (Football, Hockey, Basketball, Baseball, Dance Team, One Act Play, Soccer, Softball, and Volleyball) in a larger tournament classification may appeal their placement to the MSHSL office provided that the criteria below is met:

1.1 The schools' free/reduced lunch counts provided to the League office by the Department of Education exceeds 50% of the school's grade 9-12 enrollment or, MSHSL enrollment for grades 9-12 is within 10% of the classification cut-off number for the class to which the school is appealing

- Geographic/contiguity
- Section balance






# The Differential in Number of Assigned Teams in Competitive Sections at the time of placement shall be as follows:

#### Two classes:

- Class AA: Unless otherwise determined by the Board of Directors, in the initial year of the two-year assignment, the differential shall
  not exceed two (2) teams in each competitive section.
- Class A: Unless otherwise determined by the Board of Directors, in the initial year of the two-year assignment, the differential shall
  not exceed four (4) teams in each competitive section.


## Multiple Class (three or more):


• Unless otherwise determined by the Board of Directors, in the initial year of the two-year assignment, the differential shall not exceed two (2) team for any class.



#### **Competitive Section Placement**


## Boys Basketball – Class A
