Spectator Policies and Information

- Guests should stay home if they are sick or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19
- Camera tri-pods/mono-pods and “selfie sticks” are NOT allowed.
- **SPECTATOR BAG POLICY**

For enhanced safety and speed of entry, we encourage guests not to bring bags of any kind. Bags, purses and backpacks are not allowed.

 - Clutch, wristlet and wallets sized 4" x 6" x 1.5" or smaller are allowed and subject to inspection. Please allow extra time for entry.
 - Diaper bags and medical bags are allowed and may be searched.
 - If students are taking a fan bus to the event, please communicate this policy with them. Backpacks need to be left at school or on the bus.
 - These bag policies apply to SPECTATORS (not participating gymnasts, judges or tournament workers who enter via the Pass Gate). If gymnasts are coming to watch a session as a spectator, they would need to follow these bag policies.
 - PLEASE NOTE: these bag policies are in effect for the 2023 State Gymnastics Meet. Other MSHSL State Tournaments and events held at the RiverCentre/Xcel Center may have different policies.
- No beverages, food or noisemakers will be allowed to be brought into the facility.
- No balloons, laser pointers, noisemakers, air-horns, horns, drums, or whistles will be allowed in the facility.
- No weapons of any kind including licensed concealed carry weapons, knives, etc.
- No signs or banners may be hung in the facility. Hand-held signs allowed (can be held by one person).
