<p>3:30pm</p> <p>–</p> <p>3:45pm</p>	<p>Alliance selection</p> <p>The top four (4) seeded teams become ALLIANCE CAPTAINS and selects their ALLIANCE partners for the playoff round following the process described in section 11.7.1 of the 2022 FRC Game Manual.</p> <p>These alliances will be three team alliances unless an alliance later calls in a backup.</p>
<p>4:00pm</p>	<p>Playoff Matches</p> <p>The playoff matches are a double elimination tournament. The double elimination bracket is described in the 2023 MSHSL Robotics State Tournament Rules document.</p> <p>The alliance that loses Match 5 (round 3 - lower bracket finals) is the State Tournament's 3rd place winner.</p>
<p>5:45pm</p>	<p>Estimated time of awards ceremony. The awards ceremony will begin immediately following the end of playoff matches.</p>
