

# STUDENT MEDIA PROGRAM

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of the Student Media Program is to:

- Provide students with an experiential learning opportunity that aligns with that of the mainstream media—including registration, check in, contest coverage.
- Provide School Media (yearbook, newspaper, etc) access to their school's state tournament experience.

### **STUDENT MEDIA DESIGNATION:**

- 1. School Media from each school are designated:
  - a. Student Media (Max of 2)
  - b. Faculty Advisor (1 required)
- 2. School Media personnel must be approved by an Activities Director.
- 3. Student Media Requirements:
  - a. Student media must be students currently enrolled at the member school.
  - b. Student media must have a school-based email account.
  - c. Team managers are not permitted to be Student Media.
- 4. Faculty Advisor Requirements:
  - a. A Faculty Advisor is required onsite at the state tournament venue at all times.
  - b. The Faculty Advisor must be a member of the school or district faculty.
  - c. The Faculty Advisor must not have other team and/or school responsibilities at the state tournament.

### **INFORMATION ABOUT SPECIFIC TOURNAMENTS:**

• Student Media are not permitted at cross country, Individual tennis, swimming and diving, alpine skiing, Nordic skiing, individual wrestling, individual gymnastics, track and field, golf and adapted bowling,

## **AT STATE TOURNAMENT VENUES**

- School Media enter the Media gate
  - o Check in with a photo ID
- The Faculty Advisor must be on site with Student Media throughout the tournament.
- School Media must follow all guidelines for mainstream media.
- School Media should work with MSHSL Media Staff at tournaments with questions.
