#### Parking

- SPECTATOR PARKING & SHUTTLE SERVICE: Spectator parking is free of charge and will be available
  on race day at the MN State Fair Lot "Block 55" at 1680 Como Avenue, Falcon Heights across the
  street from the MN State Fair Coliseum. Shuttle Parking Lot Map
- Spectators should plan to arrive at the shuttle parking lot at least 60 minutes prior to the start of the race(s) they wish to see.
- Shuttle service to and from the golf course and the parking lot will be provided from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm on race day. The shuttle pickup and drop off points will be posted with large "Shuttle Stop" signs.
- Spectator Parking is NOT ALLOWED on site at the golf course and there is limited street parking
  near the venue. Security will be at each entry point of campus and will only admit buses and team
  vans with official parking passes, and vehicles with a current disability permit or license plates.

### Spectator Policies and Information

- Guests should stay home if they are sick or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19
- Spectators are not permitted to bring cameras into League State Tournament venues. This includes both still and video cameras.
- Camera tri-pods/mono-pods and "selfie sticks" are NOT allowed.
- No beverages, food or noisemakers will be allowed to be brought into the facility.
- No balloons, laser pointers, noisemakers, air-horns, horns, drums, or whistles will be allowed in the facility.
- No weapons of any kind including licensed concealed carry weapons, knives, etc.
- No signs or banners may be hung in the facility. Hand-held signs allowed (can be held by one person
- No drones allowed.
- SPECTATORS ON COURSE: Instruct spectators from your school to stay behind the fences in order that all runners will have a fair opportunity to do their best. Spectator interference may result in the disqualification of a team or individual.
