ADMISSION RATES: \$5 Students & \$10 Adults (except Hockey at AMSOIL is \$6 & \$11).

OFFICIALS MILEAGE ALLOWANCE: One mileage will be paid based on the federal mileage rate after the first 20 miles one way, if multiple vehicles are necessary the mileage will be split. **Mileage cap \$100**

JUDGES MILEAGE (FINE ARTS): 20-50 miles (\$20), 51-100 miles (\$40), 101+ miles (\$60), if multiple vehicles are necessary the mileage will be split.

USUAL & CUSTOMARY: The amount you pay for that job during your regular season home events.

FACILITY RENTAL: The region does not pay rent if you are the high seed and are hosting the game. We will pay rent to facilities that are hosting without their school involved.

HOSPITALITY: Neutral or section championship sites must receive approval from the region secretary in advance for hospitality room funds not to exceed \$100. No hospitality will be allocated if there is only one contest taking place or the duration of the event is less than three hours. Itemized receipts are required for all expenditures.

MEALS: If the duration of a Region event is five or more hours then the tournament manager can request a meal allowance up to \$5 for each worker affected. Itemized receipts are required for all expenditures.

FEES CHARGED TO COMPETE IN REGION 7A EVENTS

- Tennis and Nordic Ski will be assessed \$100 per team paid to Region 7A and given to the event manager. Individual events/entries are \$15 per individual.
- Track, Cross Country, and Golf will be assessed \$200 per team (boys & girls teams separate). \$40 per individual entry.

Schools, who don't charge admission to activities the Region has set ticket prices for, will not be reimbursed for the cost of workers or officials (i.e. Baseball, Softball). Admission should be charged whenever possible.

LATE FEES

• Entry fees are due prior to participation and tournament reports including the gate receipts are due within one week of the event. Late payments will be assessed \$150 if they have not been received within a month of the event and an additional \$50 will be applied every week thereafter.
